Construction Update

Construction has now commenced in Strathnairn, Stage 1 of the Ginninderry Project, with works well underway and progressing rapidly. New linemarking, medians and bus stops on Drake-Brockman Drive have also been installed as part of the construction. In the first two months of construction over 45,000m³ of earthworks have been completed and in excess of 1,500m of underground service infrastructure installed.

The successful construction of a High Efficiency Sediment (HES) Basin was an important milestone. The basin continuously monitors and treats the pH and turbidity of construction run-off water and is an important environmental control after rain events.





Figure 2 – High Efficiency Sediment Basin Flowchart



Major Work on site

The major works on site over the next 2 months include:

- Display Village civil works
- Earthworks for Stage 1A
- Hydraulic reticulation for Stage 1A
- Road construction for Stage 1A
- Completion of Drake-Brockman Drive works

Important Notices

The Strathnairn entrance and car park has been relocated to the south with a new temporary road installed. Huon would like to remind users of both the Arts centre and the Link building that access to the Huon site is restricted to construction vehicles only and advise road users to take care on Stockdill Drive.


New Alignment =
