



Completion of Stage 1

Huon Contractors has successfully completed Stage 1 of Ginninderry. All up, Stage 1 of the project contained a total of 316 blocks as well as various other works such as the construction of a sewer vortex connection to an existing sewer tunnel 40m underground; construction of the display village and an irrigation reticulation system throughout key areas of the estate.

The project was a success, with Huon meeting all key milestone dates, delivering work of a high quality and also winning an award at the CCF Earth Awards for the sewer vortex structure.

The GX Display Village located in Stage 1 has now also been completed and is open to the public.

Award of Stage 2

Huon Contractors has recently been awarded the contract for Stage 2 of Ginninderry. We are looking forward to continuing our relationship with Riverview Projects and Calibre Professional Services, who are the respective client and superintendent for the project.

Construction commenced on-site in September and is progressing well. Earthworks are nearing completion and we are also well into hydraulic reticulation, consisting of sewer, stormwater and water mains.

SPARK Training & Employment Program Continues

As part of Stage 1 Ginninderry, Huon was required to provide 10 unpaid work experiences of 1 week duration along with 5 permanent positions to residents of the West Belconnen area through the SPARK initiative of Riverview Projects.

This will continue in Stage 2, with Huon searching for an additional 8 work experience placements and 4 full time positions. More information about the SPARK program can be found on the Ginninderry website.

Strathnairn Carpark

The first milestone achieved for Stage 2 of the project, was the completion of the Strathnairn car park. The car park sits adjacent to The Link building and was required to be built in a very short timeframe in order to be opened for the display village timing.

The works involved the removal of a sewer absorption trench, reconfiguring existing services and created a sealed carpark, along with irrigated turf and planting beds.

There are also numerous landscaping features including seating logs, stepping stones and aluminium blade fencing.
