SPARK Ginninderry proudly supports training and employment initiatives for local people.

SPARK in partnership with TAFE NSW (RTO Code: 90003) and the Yass Valley Anglican Church are delivering an innovative accredited training program focusing on skills development, work experience and potential employment within the construction sector.

Specifically targeting people living within the Yass Valley and surrounding region, this program will:

- Provide participants with a Certificate I in Construction (CPC1011) and a Certificate II Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways (FSK2019) upon successful completion – duration 10 weeks.
- Provide participants with a Certificate II in Construction Pathways (CPC2021) upon successful completion – additional 5 weeks.
- Provide industry specific training delivering an specific infrastructure project for the Yass Valley Anglican Church that will include concreting, paving, timber work, excavation and brick and block laying.
- Provide potential employment pathway opportunities, including apprenticeships.
- Supply an Industry induction card, Asbestos awareness card and Personal Protective Equipment for participants that successfully join the program.

Commencing Monday 9 August 2021, this 15 week program will run 3 days per week (Mon–Wed, 21 hours per week) and be a combination of theory, practical hands on learning and industry work experience.

The information session will provide individuals with advice on eligibility criteria, program content and the commitment that is required to be selected as a participant on this program.
