Site Clean Procedure

RSS is committed to ensuring that all our worksites are maintained to a clean and safe standard. We need all builders work with us to ensure we achieve our aim.

Our cleans are broken into 4 main stages, as follows:

1. **Stage One / Slab Stage** – Excess steel removed, excess spoil removed and back blade if required.
2. **Stage Two / Brick & Cladding Stage** – Brick and roofing material removed.
3. **Stage Three / Gyprock Stage** - Gyprock removed.
4. **Stage Four /Final Clean and Handover** – All material removed; site back bladed if required.

From the commencement of the build, RSS will conduct site visits at regular intervals ensuring the site and bags are maintained. We call this a Tidy Site. Our bags are set up prior to the slab stage commencing and are regularly checked and changed over when we complete a Tidy site.

We will remove all waste including bricks, as the waste is generated. We will remove recyclable material as it is generated also.

Please allow all trades to finish and notify RSS if additional waste is to be removed from the garage prior to this clean so no residual waste remains.
