



Introducing Ginninderry's new walking track.



The Link to Shepherds Lookout

The new walking track connects the urban area of Ginninderry to the popular Shepherds Lookout. Starting from The Link, the track weaves its way for 3.4 kilometres through the Ginninderry Conservation Corridor before connecting with the existing ACT Government track network that takes you to Shepherds Lookout.

The track provides access to areas that were previously inaccessible to the public. It weaves through two forest types and native grassland areas and passes ever-changing vegetation types and landscapes, including the vista captured in the painting *Weetangera* (1937) by Elioth Gruner.

- 5 Wallaroo Spur**
