

## Application for Flexi-living Home Package

### APPLICATION INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

#### References to “you” and “your”

A reference to “you” or “your” below is a reference to the Applicant or Applicants to be specified in the Application for a Package.

#### 1. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to purchase a Package you must meet the following Eligibility Criteria.

- 1.1. you and your Domestic Partner do not own any real property either alone or jointly with anyone;
- 1.2. at least one Applicant intend to occupy the home for a continuous period of at least 3 years, beginning within the first year of settlement and must not rent the home before occupying it;
- 1.3. the Applicant/s undertake that they intend to not on sell the home for a minimum of 3 years from the date of settlement; and
- 1.4. for the 12 months prior to purchasing a Package, the combined Total Gross Income of all applicants and their Domestic Partner/s is less than or equal to \$120,000 (regardless of the number of dependants).

Eligibility criteria may vary.

#### 2. Acceptance or Rejection of Application

Applications for a Package will be assessed by Ginninderry in accordance with the conditions and requirements advertised for this sales process and may be rejected if:

- 2.1. You do not meet the Eligibility Criteria above; or
- 2.2. You or your Domestic Partner already have an exchanged Contract for a Package; or
- 2.3. The Application for a Package has not been fully completed or executed to the satisfaction of Ginninderry; or
- 2.4. Ginninderry believes you have made a false declaration in the Application for a Package; or
- 2.5. The Application for a Package does not otherwise comply with the Applicable Conditions.

#### 3. Deposit in instalments

The Deposit will be paid in the following instalments:

- 3.1. \$5,000 when you purchase a Package at the Ginninderry Sales and Information Centre, The Link (First Instalment);
- 3.2. the balance of 5% of the purchase price payable under the Contract at exchange (Second Instalment); and
- 3.3. the balance of 10% of the purchase price payable under the Contract at settlement (Third Instalment) (which will be at the same time that you pay the remainder of the purchase price, such that you are paying the remaining 95% of the purchase price at settlement).



The First Instalment, Second Instalment and Third Instalment together form the Deposit payable under the Contract. The First Instalment will form part of the Second Instalment required at exchange of contracts for a Package. The first instalment of the deposit may be made by ways of EFTPOS, credit card or a cheque in favour of "Riverview Sales & Marketing Pty Ltd". The second and third instalments of the deposit may only be made by way of a cheque in favour of "Suburban Land Agency". If you exchange the Contract but do not complete the purchase of the Package, any instalments paid will be forfeited and you are liable for any damages suffered by Ginninderry.

Under the Contract, no interest will be paid to you by Ginninderry in respect of the Deposit.

#### 4. Statutory Declaration

You will be required to obtain legal advice and provide to Ginninderry's legal adviser, completed and executed Statutory Declarations (attached to this application) for the following:

- 4.1. Statutory Declaration (witnessed by the solicitor who provided the advice), which declares that you will satisfy the Eligibility Criteria; and
- 4.2. Statutory Declaration provided by a Registered Tax Agent that declares that you satisfy the applicable Total Gross Income test requirements included as part of the Eligibility Criteria.

The above declarations are required to be provided at exchange of the Contract. If you are unable to provide the Statutory Declarations at that time, exchange will not proceed and Ginninderry may elect to return the package to the market.

If you have provided false or misleading information in any of the Statutory Declarations, Ginninderry may terminate the Contract and pursue any other rights set out in the Contract including retaining an amount of \$2,750 (including GST) to cover its administration expenses and other costs.

#### 5. Stamp duty

Please note that stamp duty is payable on a Flexi-living Home Package in the same way as it is payable on a Standard Lease.

From 18 September 2017, stamp duty is payable to the ACT Revenue Office after you register the title to your property at Access Canberra in Dickson.

  - 6.10.4. includes income from all sources, such as benefits from a salary packaging arrangement, value of benefits from reportable fringe benefits, reportable superannuation contributions, short term higher duty payments, short term second job payments, maintenance payments, and income that is exempt income; and
  - 6.10.5. excludes employment termination payments that are payments made for years of service under a genuine redundancy payment.
