UnitingCare Kippax in partnership with North Belconnen Community Association Inc., The Y Canberra Region Early Learning Centres, The Canberra Institute of Technology (RTO Code: 0101) and The Umbrella Collective are delivering an innovative micro-credential accredited training program focusing on skills development, work experience and employment within the Early Childhood Education and Care sector in Canberra.

The information session will provide individuals with advice on program content, eligibility criteria and the commitment that is required to be selected as a participant on this program.

Please note; individuals who wish to be considered for this program must be willing to undergo a National Police Check prior to commencing. Individuals MUST also have applied for a Working With Vulnerable People card and produce the receipt before being offered a place on the program.

Targeting people living within Belconnen and the wider region, this program will:

- ✓ Provide participants with 7 accredited units from the Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121) upon successful completion.
- Provide industry specific training designed in partnership with the Early Childhood Education and Care sector.
- ✓ Provide real employment pathways within the Early Childhood Education and Care sector for participants who meet the criteria.
- Provide industry based work placements within the Early Childhood Education and Care sector.

Commencing Wednesday 1 May 2024 at CIT Bruce Campus, this 19-week program will run 4 days a week (Tues - Fri, 30 hours per week) and be a combination of theory, practical hands-on learning and sector work placement.
