SPARK in partnership with The Canberra Institute of Technology (RTO Code: 0101), CIT Renewable Energy Skills Centre of Excellence, The Umbrella Collective, UnitingCare Kippax and Local Jobs Capital Region are delivering an accredited training program focusing on skills development and further education, training and employment within the electrotechnology, renewables and construction sectors.

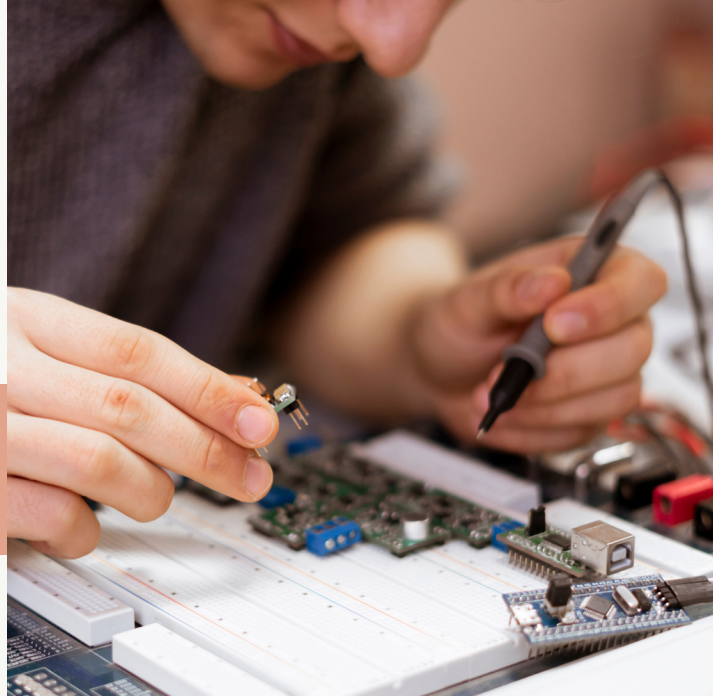
Targeting people living in Canberra who are 17 years of age or older and who are not enrolled in high school/college.

This SPARK program will include:

- Apply work health and safety regulations, codes, and practices in the workplace (UEECD0007)
- Fabricate, assemble and dismantle utilities industry components (UEECD0019)
- Fix and secure electrotechnology equipment (UEECD0020)
- Use drawings, diagrams, schedules, standards, codes and specifications (UEECD0051)
- Apply environmentally and sustainable procedures in the energy sector (UEERE0001)
- Non accredited training in Introduction to soldering

Commencing Tuesday 21 July 2026, this program will be delivered at CIT Fyshwick campus and run for 7 weeks, 3 days per week (Tuesday - Thursday, 18-21 hours a week) during Term 3. This program will be a combination of theory, practical hands-on learning, site tours and guest speakers.

Participants who successfully complete this taster program have the option of continuing in the Certificate II in Electronics (UEE21920) at CIT Fyshwick in 2027.



### Information Session

The information session will provide individuals with advice on program content, eligibility criteria and the commitment that is required to be selected as a participant on this program. It is mandatory that all individuals seeking to be on the program attend this session.

This is a two-part session broken into:

1. an information presentation followed by;
2. a selection session for eligible individuals.
