

# LAUNCH INTO LEARNING FOR MIGRANTS AND REFUGEES

UnitingCare Kippax in partnership with The Canberra Institute of Technology (RTO Code: 0101), Navitas Skilled Futures, Multicultural Hub Canberra, Capital Local Jobs Program, Ginninderry Conservation Trust and The Umbrella Collective are delivering an innovative training program specifically designed to help migrants, refugees and asylum seekers prepare for Vocational, Education and Training (VET) pathways.

This program includes practical workshops covering workplace culture, English language, digital literacy, and study skills.

Participants will build confidence, study readiness, and community connections in an inclusive environment.

Targeting migrants and refugees living in Canberra, who are 17 years of age or older.

This program includes:

  - Speaking and Listening
  - Reading
  - Writing
  - Digital
- ✓ Conversational English classes
- ✓ Australian Workplace Culture workshop
- ✓ Guided walks in the Ginninderry Conservation Corridor

Starting **Thursday 6 August** this 15-week program will run two days a week (Thursdays & Fridays) and will finish in November.
